Dr. Stephanie Baker is an organizer and trainer with the Racial Equity Institute, a member of the Black Pearls Society, Incorporated, and Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated. Dr. Baker hopes to contribute to racial justice, social justice, and liberation movements through teaching, research, mentoring, and community and institutional organizing.

Her research interests include social determinants of racial health equity, community-based participatory research, and using racial equity, antiracism, and intersectionality lenses to understand and address health inequities. Dr. Baker partners with several grassroots and community organizations including SpiritHouse, Inc. in Durham, NC to promote transformative community healing, health and wellbeing and the Alamance County Health Equity Collective, a community-based participatory research partnership created to address health equity by centering its work on the Community Health Assessment (CHA) and Community Health Improvement Plans (CHIP). Dr. Baker was also a 10 year member of the Greensboro Health Disparities Collaborative in Greensboro, NC, a partnership that addressed racial inequities in breast and lung cancer treatment.



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
